Buttercup Nursery Autumn Term

We will be using Target tracker to record observations and communicate with you about your children. Early Years Foundation Stage - Prime Areas

Personal, Social and Emotional development

This term we will be focusing on becoming familiar with the learning environment and the rules which we follow in nursery. We will have the opportunity to free flow play indoors and outdoors in our environments. We will also be looking at family, and sharing photos of our loved ones.

Physical development

This term we will introduce 'Go Noodle' to the children, working on co-ordination daily. Funky fingers will develop fine motor skills which will support handwriting. PE sessions will be introduced to improve children's gross motor skills.
