Our WOW day will be a Buttercup quest, which will lead onto a fabulous banquet.

We will also be inviting parents in to share their favourite stories with the children.



This term the Buttercups will be using their imagination to recreate Superhero and fantasy role play experiences.

Each week the children will continue to have a focus book; this will allow children to build on their vocabulary and use this within their play.

They will work on their story recall. And continue to encourage the children to use their words to make more complex sentences.

Children will also take part in group time activities; this will involve turn taking and working on our listening skills. The focus will be maths and literacy/phonics. Children will either learn the pictures that represent the sounds or the sound cards.

Nursery staff will continue to observe children using tapestry and add to their learning journeys, we would be grateful if you can continue this at home.

The Buttercups will continue to cook once a week and build upon their cooking skills.

We will also have the opportunity to visit our local community on a regular basis.

## Early Years Foundation Stage - Prime Areas

### Personal, Social and Emotional development

This term we will be welcoming some new friends and showing them our nursery routines and focusing on becoming familiar with the learning environment and the rules which we follow in nursery. We will have the opportunity to free flow play indoors and outdoors in our environments.

### Physical development

This term we will continue with our 'go noodle', dough disco and funky fingers sessions. We will also be practising our kinetic poses and strengthening our bodies to become strong writers. The children will learn about personal hygiene and why it is important. PE sessions will continue twice a week with children practising how to dress themselves.

### Communication and Language

This term children will continue to listen to stories and build up their vocabulary based on their own experiences. The children will have the opportunity to express this language in their role play with their peers.
