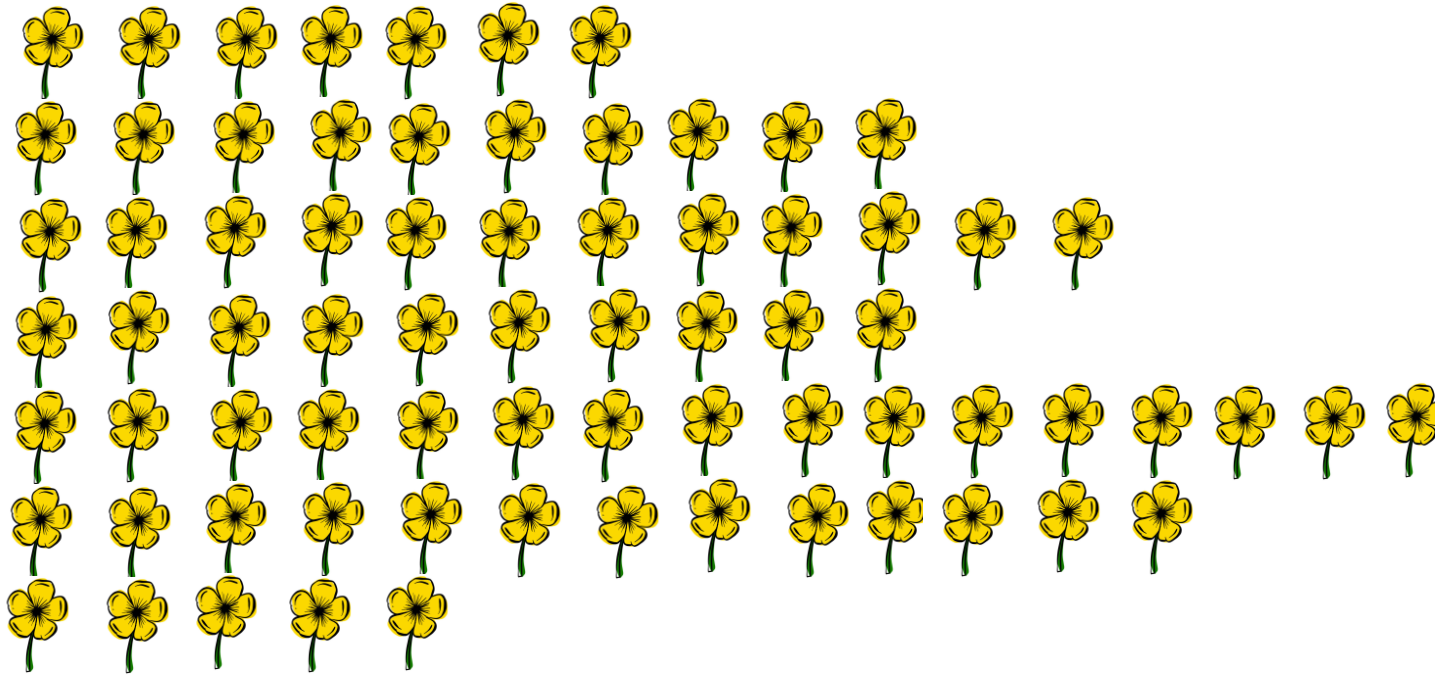




Meadowside Primary School Parent & Carer Survey Results Nov. 2021

Responses collected 1st October to 1st November 2021

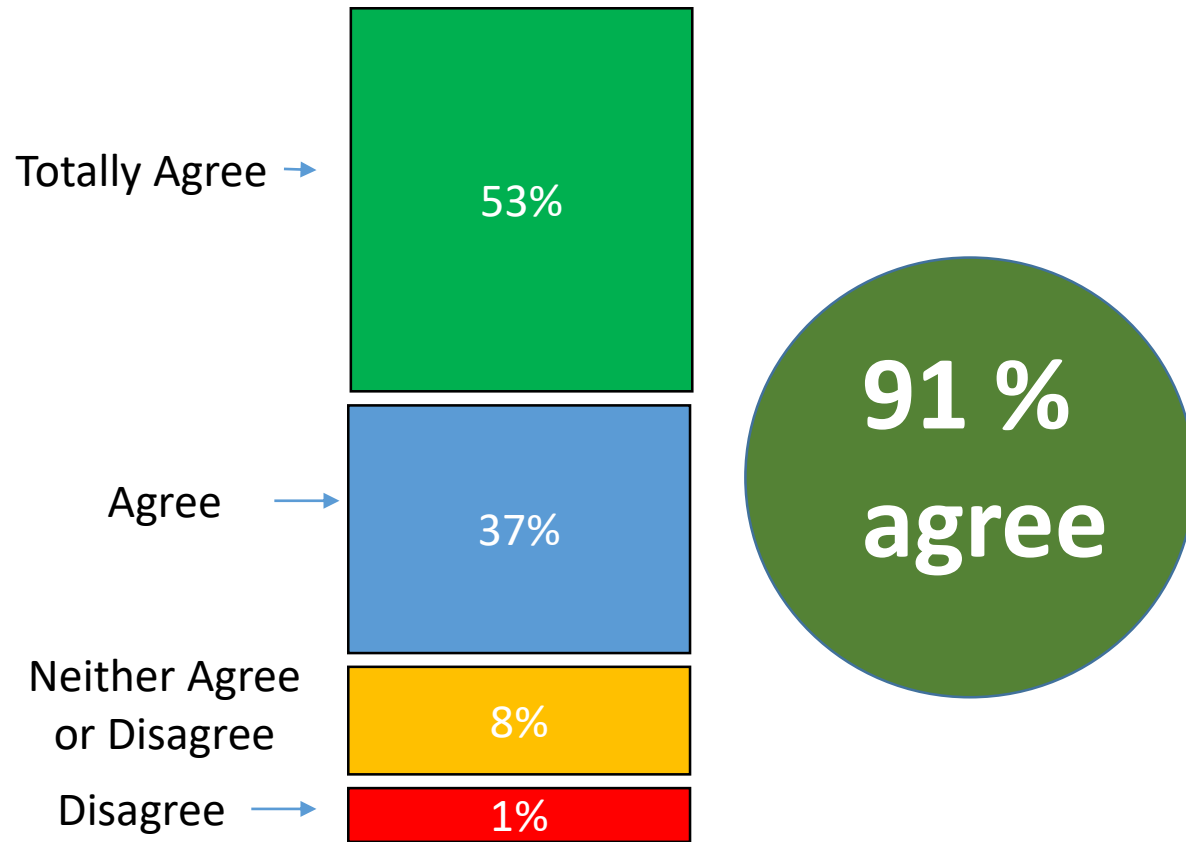


Growing at Meadowside Primary School

Headline news

- The large majority recognise that Meadowside is a safe environment where children are happy and are looked after with great care. (89% agree)
- The vast majority think their children do well at this school (91% agree)
- In general parents feel that school lets them know how their child is doing. (66% agree)
- Some would welcome more communication about progress and the support they can provide at home. (15%)
- The large majority of parents believe that the school makes sure that pupils are well behaved. (87% agree).
- Most parents of children believe the school supports their child's wider personal development (75%). However 19% parents are not aware.

My child likes being back in school. My child likes her class and always comes home happy.

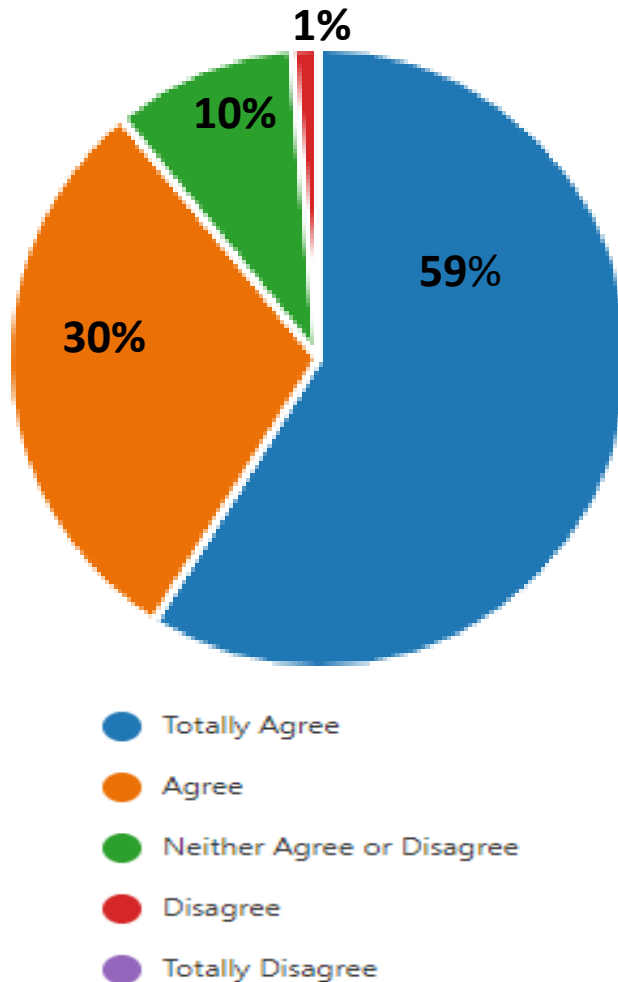

A great school, I moved my child from another school and the provision here meets her and our needs much better.

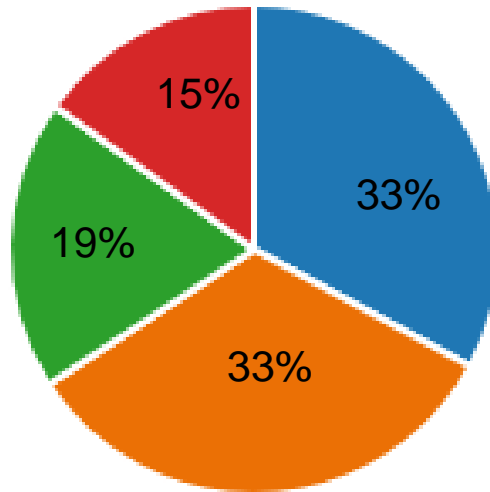
The school used to be a home from home school now I feel it's just about number! Where has the care gone?

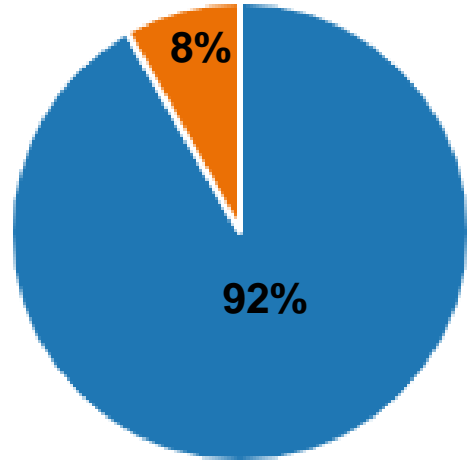
Teachers and senior staff clearly put the education and welfare of the children first.

I'm really happy with my son's progress since starting school. He likes getting a gold star and seems to enjoy it.

I am pleased with how well my daughter fits into Meadowside. I don't have much contact with her teacher but my daughter tells me what each day has taught her. I have needed information regarding after school clubs and her teachers were able to help. My daughter is happy and that is all I am concerned about.

In general it's a very good school just sometimes a little slow in getting information when needed to parents if something has happened that may affect a child but isn't serious.

I have always felt we had good feedback from the teachers on our child's progress. However this year I have barely had 2 words from their teacher on collection. The rapport is not the same this year as we have had in the past which has been disappointing.

A good school is where your child is happy to go at. My daughter goes every day with a smile and comes back home with her favourite saying "the school was epic today" As a parent I don't have to hear anything else. Meadowside is really, really improving.
